

# SATS JUNIOR TRAVELLING FELLOWSHIPS 2017/18 –

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The SATS Junior Travelling Fellowships have been made available by the South African Thoracic Society, for the purpose of promoting expertise in the field of respiratory medicine. They are intended for training and to build research capacity in this field. They are not available for use to attend congresses.

1. The Fellowships are tenable at any local or overseas university approved by SATS. They may also be used to cover expenses related to participating in SATS-approved research and/or training courses, but not conference attendance.
2. The total value of the Fellowships is R15,000/year (divided into two awards). The amount may be divided up into smaller amounts up to a maximum of R5000 for each individual. Fellowships may run concurrently with other awards from commercial sponsors and additional research grants for equipment and running expenses may be obtained from the host institution, a university or Medical Research Council. No additional funds will be provided by the South African Thoracic Society.
3. The Fellowships are open to all junior medical graduates of South African universities or South African clinical technologists, or those who have been domiciled in South Africa for a minimum of three years. They must be in a training programme at an accredited academic pulmonology unit and members of the South African Thoracic Society.
4. The Scholarship Selection Committee is a standing Committee of the South African Thoracic Society and comprises senior members from South African Universities.
