

SATS SENIOR TRAVELLING FELLOWSHIP

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The SATS Senior Travelling Fellowships have been made available by the South African Thoracic Society, for the purpose of promoting expertise in the field of respiratory medicine. It is intended primarily for training and to build research capacity in this field.

1. The Fellowship is tenable at any local or overseas university approved by SATS. The Scholarship Selection Committee is a standing Committee of the South African Thoracic Society and comprises senior members from South African Universities.
2. The fellowship is open to all senior medical or science graduates of South African universities or graduates who have been domiciled in South Africa for a minimum of three years, and are members of the South African Thoracic Society. Applicants should have a track record of research in pulmonology.
3. The value of the Fellowship is R20 000,00 for subsistence support for the grant holder. The fellow's basic salary has to be funded by his/her home/hospital/institution. The fellowship may run concurrently with other awards from commercial sponsors and additional research grants for equipment and running expenses may be obtained from the host institution, a university or Medical Research Council. No additional funds will be provided by the South African Thoracic Society.
4. Applications will only be considered for training relating to pulmonology.
5. The Travelling Fellow may undertake his/her training at any institution of their choice. The period may vary according to particular circumstances.
